

**May 2, 2011**

Before the meeting, the civic center meeting room that the club uses was having a special election for the Bellaire council. The club meeting was moved to the recreation center youth room. There was no drawing; we did have tickets, just not used, so nobody won the show and tell prize.

**May 16, 2011**

The last meeting at the civic center maybe June 7. the rental of the civic center meeting room is \$50 per meeting. The library is free, but we donate \$1000 to the library. 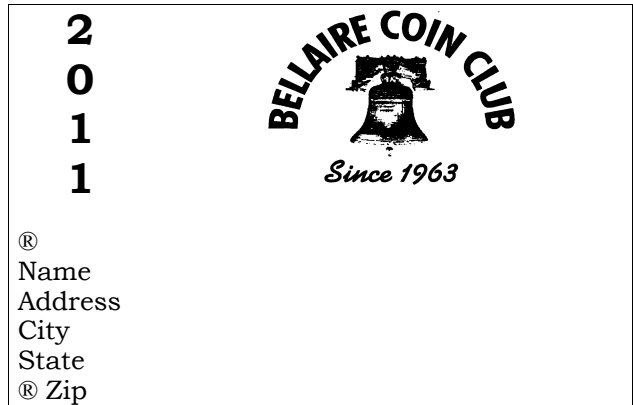

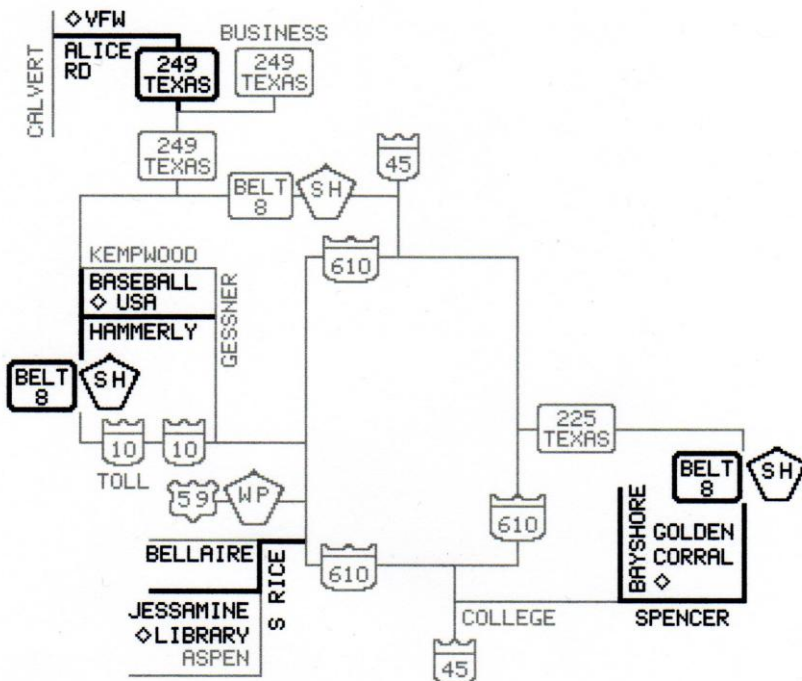
